PROXY - Felony custodial arrests, Diversion Program/Charging COMPAS - Cash bonds, Sentencing, Probation Supervision

## **Risk-Based Custodial Arrest and Pretrial Release Process**

Felony custodial arrests

Low-risk not held on cash bond unless Wisconsin Supreme Court bond factors present.

Cash bonds

- Expedited cash bond review based upon pretrial COMPAS information.

## **Evidence-Based Sentencing Practices**

Probation supervision

Reserved for medium and high-risk individuals, absent compelling public interest

Incarceration

- Jail imposed as condition of probation only as minimally necessary
- Prison reserved for situations in which a compelling safety need is present or a COMPAS

# **Evidence-Based Probation Supervision Process**

Dosage based probation Minimal amount of incarceration necessary to provide break in chain of behavior

### EBDM outcomes in 2015

**Pre-charge Diversion** 

- Diverted from arrest over 1,000 low risk/first time offenders from the system
- 2015 diverted 242 persons
- Collected \$25,000 in restitution
- Recidivism study shows an 80% increase in recidivism if not in the program over a 2 year period.

Community Transition Center (CTC

- 708 persons referred
- 392 bond clients served
- 17,538 bed days diverted

#### Jail

- Pretrial holds only 1.7 days
- Maintain .6% growth since 2012
- ADP decrease 5.9% from 2014 to 2015
- 5.7% Increase in bookings from 2014-2015
- 16.8% of jail bed days used on meth involved cases

#### Clearance Rates

- 2012 was 96% and increase to 101% in 2015
- Felony case dispositions increase 49.5% from 2012-2015
- Misdemeanor cases decreased more than 12% since 2010
